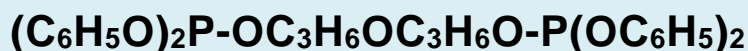


DOVERPHOS 11

Doverphos 11 is tetraphenyl dipropyleneglycol diphosphite. It has a high phosphorus content with high molecular weight and low viscosity. **Doverphos 11** is recommended for use as a stabilizer in rigid and plasticized PVC applications where high gloss is important. In film applications, the use of **Doverphos 11** results in low color. Typical use levels range from 0.25 to 1.00%.
